

New Pool Passes Needed for 2021

As the 2020 pool season comes to a close, all pool passes will expire on 9/13/20.

That means that EVERYONE (5 years old and up) must have new pool passes made in 2021.

Instructions on how to get your new pool passes will be included in the assessment packages that will be mailed out at the end of February 2021 so PLEASE look over that section carefully to see what you need to do to get new passes. Instructions will also be posted on our official website at www.powderhornsc.org.

As we had several pictures that were sent in this year that were not conducive to use on the pool passes (such as where the person's face was not completely visible) and it caused delays in the creation of the pool passes, there will be guidelines to follow to help make the 2021 pool pass creation go smoothly and with less issues.

Dirt Bikes & Enduro Bikes

We have received more complaints regarding dirt bikes and enduro bikes being ridden on the streets of Powderhorn.



Per the Simpsonville Police Department, dirt bikes and enduro bikes are NOT permitted to be ridden on subdivision streets. The police department also said that for a motorcycle to be driven on the roadway, it must be registered at the Department of Motor Vehicles or at least the motorcycle must be documented as inspected. Motorcycles must also be equipped with lights, a horn and brake lights.

Per the SCDMV, you must be at least 15 years old to apply for a regular motorcycle beginner's permit to ride a motorcycle.

These are not Powderhorn's rules... these are enforced by the Simpsonville Police Department and the SCDMV.

Parking on the Streets

We have received more complaints about people continuing to park their cars long term along the streets. This is especially a problem driving towards the back of the subdivision. Parking on our streets should be temporary and not long term. Please remember that parking on the streets long term violates the Code of Ordinances of the City of Simpsonville.

Per the CODE OF ORDINANCES CITY OF SIMPSONVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA: Sec. 34-82. - Blocking streets and alleys.

No person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle upon a street other than an alley, in a manner or under conditions as to obstruct the well-traveled portion of the roadway, except that a driver may stop temporarily during the actual loading or unloading of passengers or when necessary in obedience to traffic regulations or traffic signs or signals of a police officer.
